Details on Back

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• Directions: From I-20 (Exit 22 Hwy 1 south to Rt. 78), turn left (East). Follow Rt.
• 78 approx. 5 mi. to Montmorenci. Turn left on Montmorenci Rd. (at Annie's Inn).
• Follow to second right (Fox Pond Rd.). Jumping Branch Farm is 1/2 mile on the left.
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Classes

1. **Beg. Novice-** Fences to 2’7” (12-18 efforts)
2. **Novice-** Fences to 2’11” (15-22 efforts)
3. **Training-** Fences to 3’3” (15-22 efforts)
4. **Preliminary-** Fences to 3’7” (20-25 efforts)

- All courses from ~900-1500 meters
- \$70.00 entry for add back class. (*Money, prize, ribbon, at least \$30 per entry goes toward prize money*) After closing date February 16, \$80.00
- A few years ago Doug Payne won \$500, and Ian Roberts won \$400.
- \$40.00 entry for schooling ride. (*No money, no prize, no ribbon*) After closing date February 16, \$50.00
- Beginning with Beg. Nov at 10:00am and working our way up through the levels
- Extra rides can be added on show day for \$30.
- But the first round to count only for Add Back class.
- Judged like a jumper round - fastest time wins, six seconds added per rail or stop/runout.
- 12 month Coggins required on all participants, send with entry OR phone copy acceptable day of show.
- Organizer may divide or combine classes as entries warrant.
- Hard hats with a harness required at all times when jumping.
- Medical armbands are required for all jumping. (Can be homemade)
- Braiding and coats not allowed :)
- State age and level of experience on entry.
- No rain date or entry refund - free x/c schooling in future.
- Approximate times available on web page the night before - www.jbfarm.com
- Scratch refunds allowed before midnight of C.D. Must be phoned to Julie’s cell (803)645-1098 OR e-mailed less \$15 office fee-after C.D. Only if space filled by waiting list.
- One Week Derby Schooling Fee \$30.00 to entrants. \$50.00 to non-entrants.
